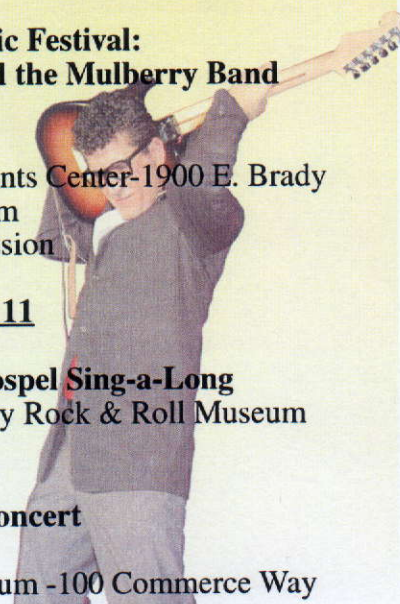

**CITY OF CLOVIS TO HOLD RIBBON CUTTING FOR GOODWIN
LAKE TRAILS**

The City of Clovis would like to invite Clovis area residents to a ribbon cutting for the Goodwin Lake Trails at 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, August 30th, 2011. The ribbon cutting will be held at the trails entrance located on the east side of Prince Street opposite Bahama Bucks.

The Goodwin Lake Trails are located on a 32 acre parcel of land owned by the City of Clovis which is primarily utilized for drainage. Apart from the trails the surrounding area will remain unchanged from its natural habitat. Furthermore, City of Clovis staff has been working with the New Mexico Nature Conservancy who will be assisting with conducting playa education programs for area schools at the playa which is located on the site.

"I am thrilled to see this thirty two acre area of our community open to the public for walking along these new trails" said Mayor Brumfield Monday. "This piece of land with its playa is not only a great opportunity to be surrounded by indigenous plants and wildlife, despite being located near a busy area of town, but also encourages health and wellness by providing a safe environment to exercise in."

"The Goodwin Lake Trails came in well under budget, costing just \$26,000 to complete" said City Manager Joe Thomas Monday. "I would like to thank Mayor Brumfield and the Commission for all their hard work in moving the Goodwin Lake Trails forward. Thanks are also due to Ms. Nancijayne Goodwin-Hilling for her support of this trail and to Mr. Ken Barnett for helping the city facilitate the completion of one of our quality of life programs."
