Flamenco guitarist, Juan Carmona, a descendant of the famed Habichuelas guitar dynasty from Granada, Spain has been called "the prince of the flamenco guitar." Twice nominated for a Latin Grammy Award for *Best Flamenco Album*, he and his band will perform both traditional Spanish and familiar Latin American works. Joining Mr. Carmona on stage is a talented group of musicians including *Sabrina Romero*, a gifted vocalist and fiery Flamenco dancer.

Mr. Carmona obtained his degree as a concert musician from the celebrated National Conservatory of Music in Paris and at the age of 26 became the first professor of flamenco guitar holding a state-awarded diploma. He has performed with such renowned orchestras as the Russian Philharmonic, the National Orchestra of Lyons and the Marseille Opera Symphony Orchestra.
